- **4. GRANTING OF DISPENSATIONS:** The Council resolved to delegate the power to grant dispensations to the clerk at the Parish Council Meeting held on 6 November 2012. The Clerk granted dispensations to all Councillors to enable them to discuss the 2017/18 precept.

5.	District & County Councillors' Reports: Councillor Burch updated the Council on the local government restructure. She advised that NDDC had voted unanimously to support the Option 2b, which was for 2 unitary councils: Unitary A: Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole, plus the services currently provided by Dorset County Council in this area. Unitary B: East Dorset, North Dorset, Purbeck, West Dorset, Weymouth and Portland, plus the services currently provided by Dorset County Council in this area. She advised that there was a Leader and Chief Executive meeting taking place at NDDC tomorrow to decide the way forward. Cllr Burch invited Members to a quiz evening on 3 March, where the MP would be the quiz master.	
6.	Update on Open Items: Recreation Ground: The Chairman advised that repair works following the break in were due to commence on 20th October. Cllr Corben advised that he had received a quote for £201.00 for replacement emergency lights, this did not include installation. He agreed to get two quotes for the installation works. Bowey Field: N.F.T.R. Neighbourhood Plan: Cllr Banning advised that he had issued distributed a Local Green Space report and an SEA Screening Report which needed to be agreed at this meeting to enable him to take them forward. The screening report needed to go to NDDC and other public bodies to assess if a full strategy was required. Cllr Banning proposed that the Local Green Space be agreed and the 3 areas of local green spaces identified be incorporated into the draft Neighbourhood Plan. This was seconded by Cllr Fox and agreed by Council. Cllr Banning proposed agreement of the SEA screening report to enable it to be forwarded to NDDC and other public bodies for assessment. This was seconded by Cllr Fox and agreed by Council. Belchalwell and Fiddleford Items: N.F.T.R. Castle Lane Footpath to Pavilion: N.F.T.R. Kissing Gates: The footpath officer had advised that the 2nd pair of kissing gates had now been installed in the field next to the allotments.
