Neighbourhood Plan: Clir Weeks advised that all feedback had now been received following the Regulation 14 consultation and the consultation report was in the process of being written. Once completed it would be brought back to the Council for approval before being submitted to NDDC. Belchalwell and Fiddleford Items: N.F.T.R. Land Bottom of Okeford Hill: The Clerk advised that she had received an email from Mr M Hitchcott, NDDC Enforcement Officer, asking if the Parish Council would be willing to submit a statement regarding the history of this case. Cllr S Corben had written a statement for the clerk to submit to NDDC. Old Orchard and Mary Gardens: N.F.T.R.
