

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF COMMON LANE, BROAD OAK

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Common Lane, Broad Oak between the junction with New Road and the junction with Copse Hill (in both directions), a distance of approximately 160 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 5th April 2021 and will remain in force for 18 months. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28th May 2021.

This Order will enable Wessex Water safe access to replace a Water Main.

An alternative vehicular route will be signed using New Road, Angers Lane & Copse Hill.
